Feedback from stakeholders: Students, Alumni, Teachers, Parents

The institute initiates structured feedback activity to obtain feedback from internal and external stakeholders. Where in which the feedbacks is collected on various points analysed and appropriate actions are taken.

#### I. Feedback from students

- Students felt that library hours should be increased or their self-study. Also suggested that number of Library books were not sufficient.
- After the completion of syllabus discussion on previous year question paper should be done.
- Exposure to statistical software packages for analysis and interpretation of data was requested by student.
- Students suggested the need for jo-oriented courses, training for facing interviews during campus selection. They also requested to provide career guidance and export talks why industrialists.

#### Action Taken:

- Library timing is extended for self-study of students and more books are added for variety of subjects.
- Trying to increase such discussions and giving more practice on solving papers and doubt clearing before semester exam.
- Sessions on how to use statistical packages where organized to familiarize the students with the recent trends in data analysis.
- Career guidance programs were given and the Placement cell supported the development of the soft skill and communication ability.

#### II. Feedback from Alumni:

- Overall alumni have suggested that the institute should focus on improving communication skills, personality development, self-motivation and confidence and good mentoring. Alumni suggested that the libraries facilities need to be improve and more internship facilities be made available to students for better industrial exposure.
- 2. Placement activities and industrial visit should be enhanced.

3. Create a database of alumni to improve networking among the alumni and to enable better contribution to their alma muttors.
